Milligan's women's soccer team saw sophomore goalkeeper Lauren McInturff honored as the Appalachian Athletic Conference defensive player of the week Monday afternoon.

"Lauren has really stepped up this past couple of weeks," said Lady Buffs coach Lisa Buckley. "She is commanding her box, and making important saves for us."

The former Dobyns-Bennett stand-out allowed just one goal in 180 minutes last week to help the Buffaloes go 2-0 on the week. McInturff turned away two shots from Southern Wesleyan and five more against Southern Virginia on Saturday.
