

Milligan wins all-sports trophy

Milligan College claimed the Appalachian Athletic Conference's Duard Walker all-sports trophy after the final standings were released on Monday following the league's spring meeting.

"After a couple of years of coming up short, we are excited to have once again captured the AAC Duard Walker All-Sports Championship and trophy," Milligan Vice President for Student Development Mark Fox said. "This was the first goal our coaches set for the department coming into this year and to have achieved that goal is very satisfying. It exemplifies the commitment to excellence on the part of the institution, coaches and players."

Milligan's women's soccer, men's basketball, men's golf and women's tennis all won regular season titles, while the women's cross country team won its eighth straight league crown, and men's and women's outdoor track and field programs captured their first AAC titles. The Buffs finished 155 points ahead of Union College in the points race. Tennessee Wesleyan was third.

Milligan has won the Duard Walker Trophy eight times since it was established in 2000. The last time the Buffs won was 2007.
