

TN native tapped for All-Star Futures Game

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. (AP) — A minor league umpire with Tennessee roots will be on the field for baseball's All-Star Future's Game in Phoenix, as well as the Major League's Home Run Derby the next night.

Will Little, who played baseball at Milligan College near Elizabethton, will work the bases during the game, in which top minor leaguers from the United States take on minor leaguers from around the world on July 10. Little will also work the left or right field line when the big leaguers try to out-slug each other the next night.

Little told The Johnson City Press he hopes to make Triple-A late this year or next season, and hopes to be working in the majors in five or six years.
