MILLIGAN COLLEGE — The first Global Youth Service Day for Northeast Tennessee will kick off April 16 at Milligan College.

Registration is under way for the event, which gives middle school and high school students the opportunity to spend a day serving their community together.

Students will begin their day at noon at Milligan, where they will receive their service assignments. They will spend the afternoon serving the needs of local organizations such as Second Harvest Food Bank, Boys & Girls Club, Coalition for Kids and many more.

They will then return to Milligan for dinner and worship. The evening service will feature music by Mosteller and guest speaker Johnny Bragg, minister at The Oaks Fellowship in Johnson City.

Established in 1988, Global Youth Service Day is the largest service event in the world with participation from more than 100 countries and millions of students annually. It is also the only event dedicated to youth and their impact on critical world issues and local communities.
