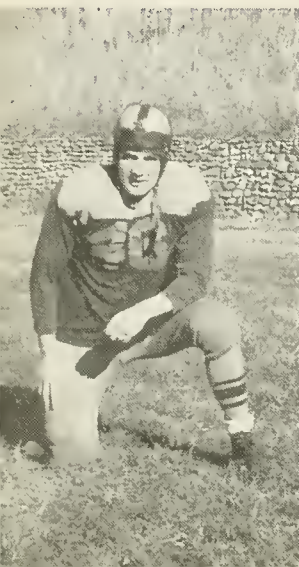
## Season Highlights
