

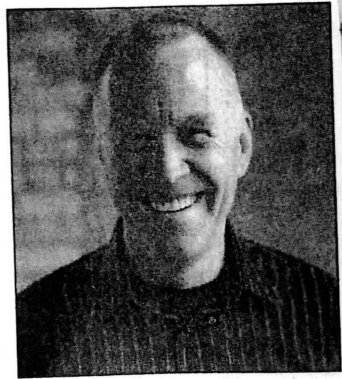
Comedian Bob Stromberg to perform at Milligan College
