

Milligan senior receives fellowship

Kara Patterson, an English major at Milligan College, is one of 10 graduating seniors nationwide to receive the H.Y. Benedict Fellowship from Alpha Chi, a national collegiate honor society.

Patterson, a native of Gastonia, N.C., graduated from Milligan on May 7. The \$2,500 fellowship will go toward her graduate studies at Clarion University of Pennsylvania, where she will

pursue a master's degree in library science.

At Milligan, she served as the president of Sigma Tau Delta, the English honor society. She has also been named to the Dean's List every semester during her studies at Milligan.

Alpha Chi's Tennessee Nu chapter at Milligan was installed in 1994. Since the chapter's inception, it has received Star Chapter

status every year but one. To earn this designation, a chapter must induct new members, sponsor at least one scholarly program on campus during the academic year, submit entries in a national scholarship competition, have at least one sponsor and at least one student attend the national convention, and have at least one student make a presentation at the convention.
