PRESIDENT GARFIELD

President James A. Garfield, who lived and died a member of the Christian Church, and was for some years a preacher in the Christian Church, was once requested by a lady to formulate a statement which would give her a more definite idea of our position in matters of faith. The following is a copy of President Garfield's statement:

- 1. We call ourselves Christians or Disciples.
- 2. We believe in God the Father.
- 3. We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, and our Saviour. We regard the divinity of Christ as the fundamental truth of the Christian system.
- 4. We believe in the Holy Spirit, both as to His agency in conversion and as a dweller in the heart of the Christian.
- 5. We accept the Old and New Eestament as the inspired Word of God.
- 6. We believe in the future punishment of the wicked and the future reward of the righteous.
- 7. We believe that Deity is a prayer hearing and prayer answering God.
- 8. We observe the institution of the Lord's Supper on every Lord's Day. To this table we neither invite nor debar. We say it is the Lord's Table, for all the Lord's children.
- 9. We plead for the union of God's people.
- 10. The Bible is our only discipline.
- 11. We maintain that all ordinances should be observed as they were in the days of the apostles.

FROM LABOR TO REWARD

Dr. Montague Frederick Robinson, son of the late Librian and Lionel Robinson, was born in Beaver Dam, Va., on October 12, 1851. Departed this life April 4, 1945. Dr. Robinson was a pioneer minister of the Christian Church, and also a medical doctor. He went from Virginia to Kentucky in his early day and there he prepared himself for the ministry and medicine. 
Honor thy mother, says the Bible; and blessed are those who remember to obey this commandment. Much has been written, said and sung about mothers. Painters have portrayed them, and great men have eulogized them. Baby's first word is usually "Mama" and in the final parting hour the last person called for is mother.

Why do mothers occupy this enviable position in the hearts of men? Is it because they they are mothers; because they know how to love. If you want to love someone sincerely, start doing things for him. That is why mother loves so much, because she is always doing so much. First, she gladly goes down into the dark valley to give life, and then any time along the way she willingly gives her all to sustain that life. She loves her little one before he is ever born. Isaiah 66:13. He offers love comparable to that of a mother. He says: "No matter what the trouble. I will comfort you. If you stumble over the roughness in the pathway of life, I will help you up. If you are lost in the darkness of the world, I will lead and guide you. If you are heart broken because you have lost a loved one, or because someone has been unkind to you, I will apply the balm of Gilead to your aching heart. If you are tired, come unto Me and I will give you rest. If you are worried about the future, remember I have gone to "prepare a place for you and I will come again and receive you unto Myself."



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TWO BIBLE RECORDED MARKINGS



Revelations of Christ to His Church By Elder A. G. Nelson Minister East Side Christian Church Kansas City, Mo.

In this discourse, we are going to attempt to expose the revelations of Jesus Christ to His Church as it applies to the markings as recorded in Rev. 13:16-17 as follows: "And He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, freed and bound, to receive the mark in the right hand or in their forehead, and that no man might buy or sell save he that had the mark or the name of the beast or the number of His name." We refer to Revelation here 13-18: "Here is wisdom, let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man and his number is 600 three score and six." This is the number that appears on the mitre or crown of the Roman Emperial Pope, when he sat in judgment on the church. This reference here before us is one of the recorded markings in the Bible that is of devilish origin. In this argument, we are going to show you the divine marking as well as the evil markings. In other words, Christ versus Satan in markings. We will also find Christ, the Son of God's markings as recorded in Rev. 20:4-5. It reads as follows: "And I saw thrones and they sat upon them; and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the Word

resurrection."

This question answered by revelation should be respected by all ministers and under-shepherds who have received the oath of God to carry out the great commission. We are saving to you in this sermon that all Protestant churches have their peculiar markings, and follows the traditions of their fore-parents the red dragon. This refers to the image that gave power to the beast, as recorded in Rev. 13:18 as follows: John speaking, "And I stood upon the sands of the sea and saw a beast rise up out of the sea having seven heads and ten horns, upon his horns ten crowns. upon his head blasphemy." This beast herein mentioned represents the pagan powers of Rome which had the markings of his father, the dragon. And we recall in Rev. 13-11. I quote: "And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth and he had two horns like unto a lamb and spake as a dragon." This is Protestantism coming into the world under deception. I refer you to my sermon on the great question just published. As we know, Protestantism came into the world under a man made decree, which had its beginning and disobedience to the honor and respect for the head of the Church of God. Christ is here trying to lead us out into the divine markings of his children. So we will know and distinguish between his markings and his adversaries markings. Let us for a moment look into this particular marking that we have before us, because the question is possibly being turned over in your mind as to how we reached this conclusion. We discovered in Rev. 13:16-17 that the Roman Catholic Church identified its communicants by marking them in the right hand. This was begun in the parents. and the seed came forth in the soil that was fertile to produce. When this child came into the world, and while

its mind was still in a dormant state, the great Roman teachers stood by like wolves to destroy the flock of the shepherd when the baby lambs are born. In this instant, he sows the seed that produces in the first stage of this child's comprehension a diversion in his thinking from the real affection of Christ to be the instrument of the

Holy Spirit, the Virgin Mary. And through training in parochial schools, higher education, colleges and catechisms they produced definite Catholic believers.

As soon as they are well versed in this doctrine. they begin to sell the same at an enormous price in confessions and through counsel as required by the Catholic group. This coincides with the verses herein above mentioned.

The Protestant group being an offspring of this former beast, the image of which gives power to the dragon, accepts the traits of their fore-parents, and carry out and continue the markings of their followers which also involves many types of Ecclesiastical ceremonies. Therefore, in many instances one can not distinguish between the Catholic worship and Protestant worship. I feel this positive identification.

You will note this marking has its tendency to disrespect, dishonor and disobey the head of the church which is Jesus Christ, the Son of God. The devil in his markings interjected into the minds of his subjects the wisdom of evil doings and taught his children to disobey the commands of Christ in his disobedience. We have before us the act of the great papal powers in Ravena sitting in Council in the year 1312 A. D. at Ravena. This mark was to train the thinking of man against Christ's commands. We quote Solomon in a statement here, when he said: "Train up a child in the way that he should go, and when he is old he will depart not from it." Here the dragon has seized this great statement and put it to work to an evil end to this great church. This is a lesson to all true God-fearing Christians, ministers and undershepherds whom God has entrusted in their hands the divine markings of His children. I need not ask this great brotherhood of listeners as to the question of the working of this great program of the Roman Catholic Church. The hand writing is on the wall of their evil success, because we are witnesses to the growth of this group of followers to the markings the world has ever known as before us to the Protestant groups in the world. We have shown you the markings and effects of the work of the beast and now we will attempt to show you the divine works of markings as recorded in the above mentioned chapter (Rev. 20:4-5).

In the beginning of the church under the influence of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.

the Holy Spirit begin its early event through the church in honor and respect to the Great Head of church. Christ, and directed the complete obedience to Christ. He also exposed to the world the wisdom of righteousness where all men might be blessed in this righteous marking. The Holy Spirit set into motion the markings that would eventually be victory to the church if the leaders who had accepted the divine oath would follow in this way. We realize that many of our leaders of this modern day have sought to short cut and seek other methods of markings that are popular to the world's thinking. In other words, they have strayed from the divine markings and accepted the evil markings as the true way of life. We quote the scripture at this point when it says: "There is a way that seemeth right unto man, but the way thereof is death."

So you see at this point Christ does not ask us to pass upon this way, but to accept it to the letter. "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the spirit sayeth unto the churches." So as you see, we are obligated to follow the divine markings as directed by the Holy Spirit which will lead the church to victory. And we as leaders should fellow and read these scriptures: Rev. 14:1; Rev. 17:5-14; Jeremiah 23:1-2-3; Jeremiah 23:18; Roman 16:17; Rev. 22:4; Rev. 13:16; Rev. 20:4; Ezekiel 9:4-6, where God commands to destroy the evil marked by the devil, but He still is a merciful Father. We find his compassion in Rev. 7:2-3 to spare His children. Now to the brotherhood, in the revelation of Jesus Christ to His church, Christ is trying to help us in this hour to retrace our steps back to Pentecost and get the fundamentals of the divine markings and produce into the world children that have been brought up as Solomon said to bring up a child in the way that he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it. In other words, they will remain with the teachings of Christ. In reference to the word "retrace," I say not the reformation movement, not to the restoration movement, but back to the Holy Spirit's beginning that we may move forward with Christ to VICTORY. Because in every one these movements play their parts in the exposition of things, but they did not have the original formula that eventually build Christ's church as He planned when He comes for it to present to His Father without blemish-pure as a virgin.

Finally, may we get down on our knees and ask God to reveal to us our shortcomings and failures to follow in the footstep of the early apostle under the influence of the Holy Spirit that we may accept this obligation without fear and go forward with Christ to success.

Will these sons of thunder be weak enough to yield to these conglomerations and mix up and mess up in the Church of Christ.


There are some preachers who will not yield to this muddle and mix up in the Church of Christ.
