EDITORIAL FROM THE CRADLE TO THE GRAVE

I knew a man who was born in a Jim Crow Hospital. Attended a Jim Crow School, worked on a Jim Crow Job, lived in the Jim Crow Section of the town, received Jim Crow Wages for his labor, traveled in the Jim Crow Train Car, rode Jim Crow Street Cars, was put in a Jim Crow Jail, ate in the Jim Crow Dining Hall. He belonged to the Jim Crow Political Party. He was a member of a Jim Crow Church. Attended a Jim Crow Church Convention. He died in a Jim Crow Hospital and was buried in a Jim Crow Cemetery. He had to die in order to get away from Jim Crowism. Heaven should be a happy place for him, where there is no Jim Crowism.

"ALARMING AND DISCOURAGING" "A FINANCIAL CRISIS"

The churches I am pastoring received a letter from President S. S. Myers, of the National Disciple's Convention, dated May 14, 1948. We quote in part:

"The report of the treasurer was alarming and discouraging. The treasurer's report revealed the fact that nine churches, only, had made a financial report since the Convention. And that we had a very small balance in the treasury. This, in itself, creates a financial crisis. I am of the opinion that you will agree with me that this emergency must be met at once because the staff workers who carry the service load must be paid. One of the staff persons of the National Convention services your particular department. The National Board needs \$5,218.78 to finish paying its share of the National Budget. We will be able to meet this budget, only in proportion as the church, the missionary organization and the church school share in the raising of this money. Therefore, we request and urge every department of the church to look upon this need as an emergency and raise some money at once to send to the treasurer, Dr. J. E. Walker, 234 Hernando Street, Memphis 1, Tennessee.

If you fail to respond to this call, our Convention will be placed in an embarrassing position which truly will be a reflection upon our ability to follow through at the point of National aspirations."

President Myers letter brings to light a statement made by the Christian Informer, "That the eyes of the churches will come open." Why call on me and the churches I am pastoring for help? Haven't you considered me an outcast? When the Indians are in trouble, they go to their "Great White Father." President Myers should go to the U. C. M. S. Didn't they help to put him in office? We told President Myers, when we turned the gavel over to him, what David said in Psalm 127:1, "Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain."

In order to save the Convention from "A FINANCIAL CRISIS" which is "ALARMING AND DISCOURAGING", we suggest that Brother Myers resign at once. And that, the National Disciple's Convention call on Elijah's God and let Baal alone.

"STICK'EM UP"

We quote in part a letter published in the June 1948 issue of the Christian Plea. "The Executive Committee of the National Christian Missionary Convention has authorized me to appoint you to promote the financial cause of the National Convention in the states of Ohio and Kentucky. This means that you are to help the National Christian Missionary Convention raise money in the states. Go to the churches and members and collect and receive money to be sent to the Treasurer."

The Christian Informer would like to know which chapter in the New Testament, that gives a Convention or an Executive Committee authority to appoint someone to go into the local church and collect money?



Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk there in, and ye shall have rest for your soul. Jr. 6:16.

We understand from our basic text that there are many ways but only one way is right and true. God will suffer these ways to be, but will not make man even to walk in the way that is right. He tells us in Jr. 21:8, Behold I set before you this day the way of life and the way of death; so it is up to us as to which way we shall travel.

With the many ways before us, we are either in the right way or we are in some way that is wrong. We have these ways set before us from which to choose —God's way—man's way; high way—low way; broad way—narrow way; the way of the transgressor—way of a fool—way of righteous—way of salvation and the way of the Cross. One of the most dangerous germs to deal with in these most perilous hours of the earth are those charged with mass deception and it is slowly but surely destroying the denominations or sectarian religious institutions and threatening to weaken, undermine or destroy the influence of the church of Christ as it, too, leans toward this false prophesy of deception. The only sure cure for this dangerous germ is the pure gospel of our Christ . . . without adulteration which is seldom preached in the world's churches.

I plead, then with the false leaders, to take God's word and read Revelations 3rd Chapt. 14-22 verses. And then fall down upon your knees and repent before it is too late because your works are an abomination in the sight of God. Also, I want the churches of Christ and the christian churches who are resorting to

some of these same types of synthetic inspiration that God is watching us as we, too, lean in this direction to try to build up mass numbers of hypocrites in the church of Jesus Christ. We forget the statement of our Christ when he said, "Narrow is the way and only a few find it." It only proves a statement of our Lord that this is all vain worship and it has no reward but it does have a wedge.

We men who are set in defense of the

gospel of Christ must defend his teaching at this point. He said the gospel is the power of God unto salvation of everyone that believes. So if we preach it and live the gospel of Christ; we won't have to resort to any of these devilish synthetic methods to keep God's church doors open and the church alive. Let us refuse to lock arms with the unbelievers and encourage them in their ways by inviting them to come into our pulpits and preach to our people whom we have told prior to their coming that they were false, otherwise, the laymen will think both of us are liars. Let us, for a moment, check with the early church methods for the apostles preach boldly the gospel throughout all Jerusalem and surrounding territory and great fear came over all the people, for they preached Christ and Him crucified and a Risen Lord. 
